



## CARY ELEMENTARY TRANSPORTATION TIPS

### Carpool

- ❑ Enter the carpool route at the Harrison Avenue/Faculty Drive entrance. Follow the flow of traffic through the parking lot, around the carpool loop, and exit on Dry Avenue.
- ❑ In the carpool loop, please wait for staff members to open your door before allowing your students to leave your car.
- ❑ When you enter the carpool loop, please have your carpool number visibly displayed. For families needing additional carpool tags (up to three per carpool number), additional tags are available in the office.

### Buses

- ❑ Please pay close attention to the route number assigned to your stop on the route list; some route numbers have changed for the coming year, even if the driver and bus number have not!
- ❑ Buses will use the front loop at the Kildaire Farm Road entrance. Please do not use this entrance unless you arrive on campus after 8:30am and/or 3:30pm. We have a large amount of bus traffic in the loop at arrival and dismissal time, as well as walkers crossing the street, and additional vehicles in the loop could pose safety problems.

- ❑ If a bus is over 30 minutes late, we will notify parents. Please return the Cary Transportation Information form included in the first Friday folder so that we will have current afternoon phone numbers readily available.

### Miscellaneous

- ❑ If your student will be going home with a friend, or in a different way than usual, please send a note with your student explaining the changes and how long they will last. We will be unable to send students home with friends or to release students to individuals not listed on the locator card without written parent permission.
- ❑ If your student walks to school from the Walnut Street side of Kildaire Farm Road, please make sure your student crosses with the crossing guard.
